Sometimes we have to supplement our power needs with our diesel generator. But most of our needs are supplied with solar, saving us over \$12,000 per year in diesel fuel expense.

She is a wonderful Christian lady and has become an important part of Aimee's life. During the week, Aimee lives with her and several family members, while going to school in Cap Haitien. This has been good for Aimee. One problem is that her grandmother lives in a shack. So we want to build a house for Aimee and her grandmother. It will cost \$7,000 to build a nice home for them on the small plot of land in Cap Haitien where the shack is currently situated. We have \$4,730, leaving a balance needed of \$2,270.
